ALUMNI MEETS



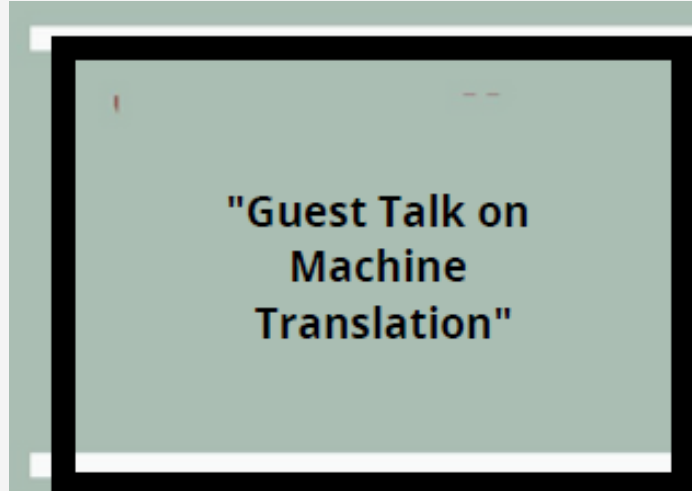

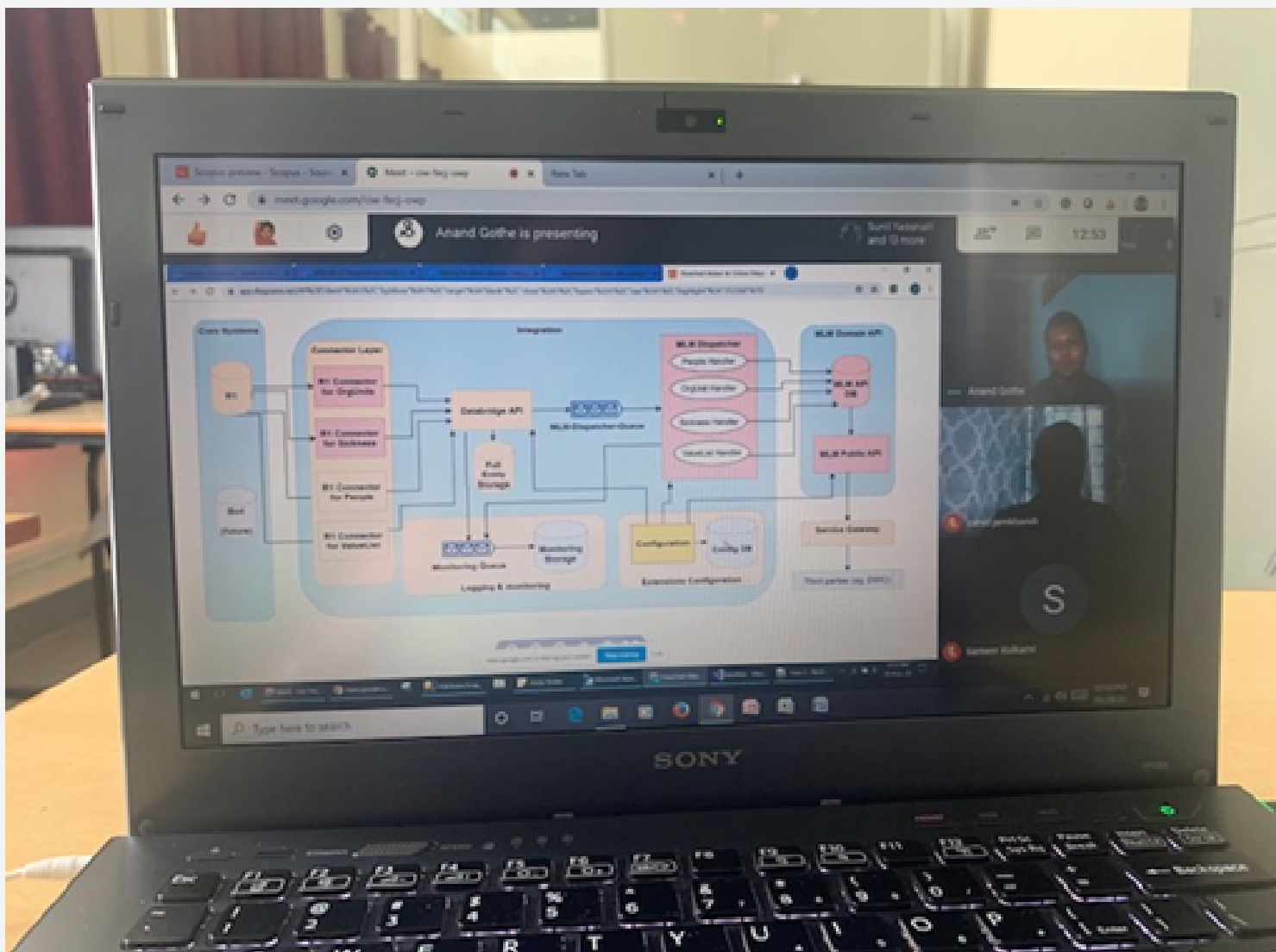
Guest Lecture on Future Trends in Information Technology

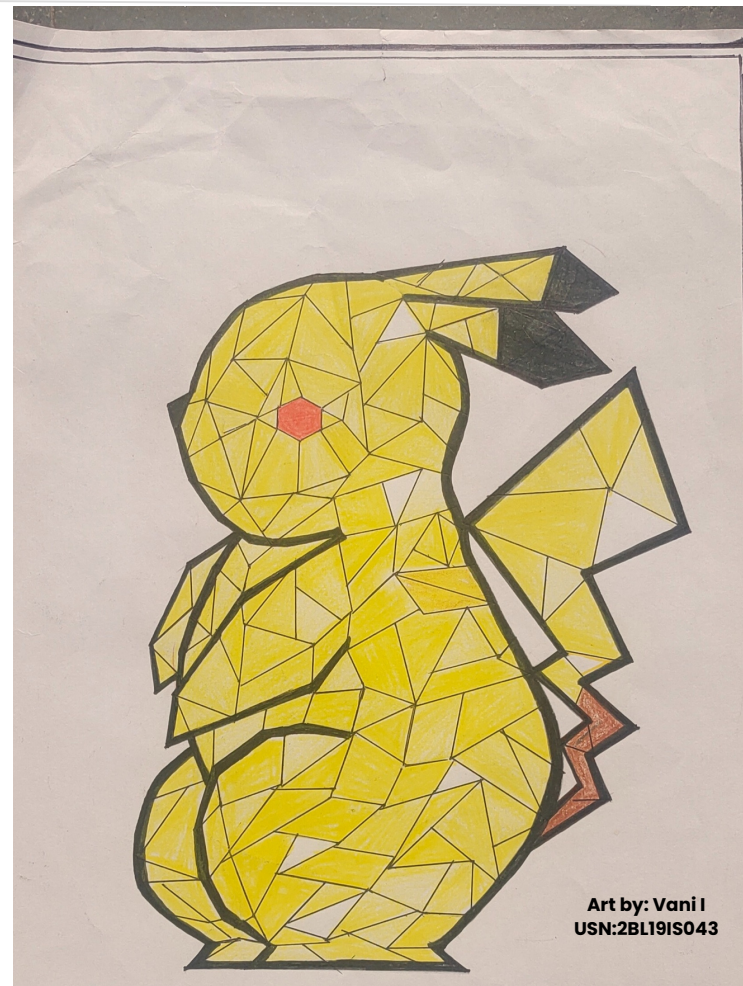
