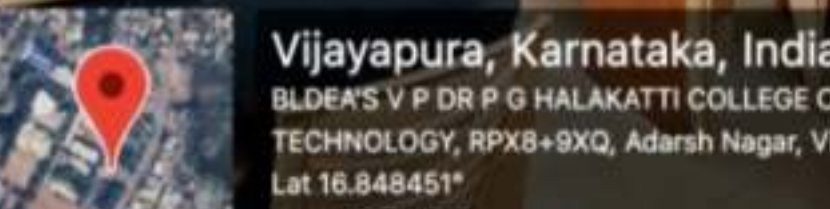

## Parents' - Teacher Meeting 2023

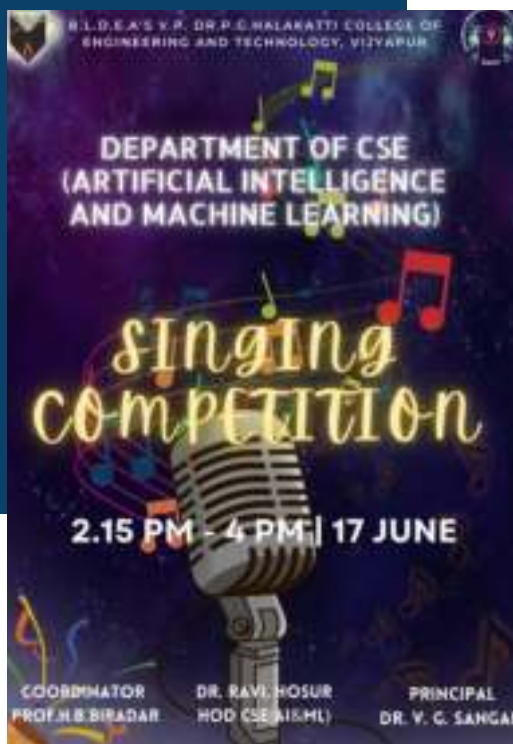

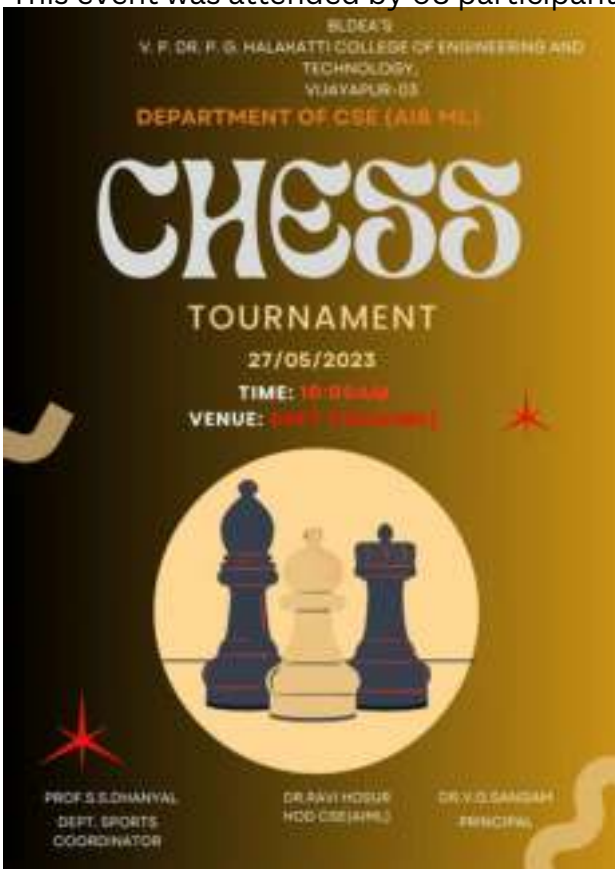

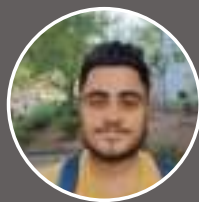
